



- The RH&DR is easily accessible from London, the M20, the Port of Dover and Eurotunnel.
- To support the long term future of the railway, a pay on exit parking system (ANPR) now applies at Hythe, Dymchurch & New Romney. Blue Badge holders are exempt, please present your badge & registration plate details to our ticket office staff.
