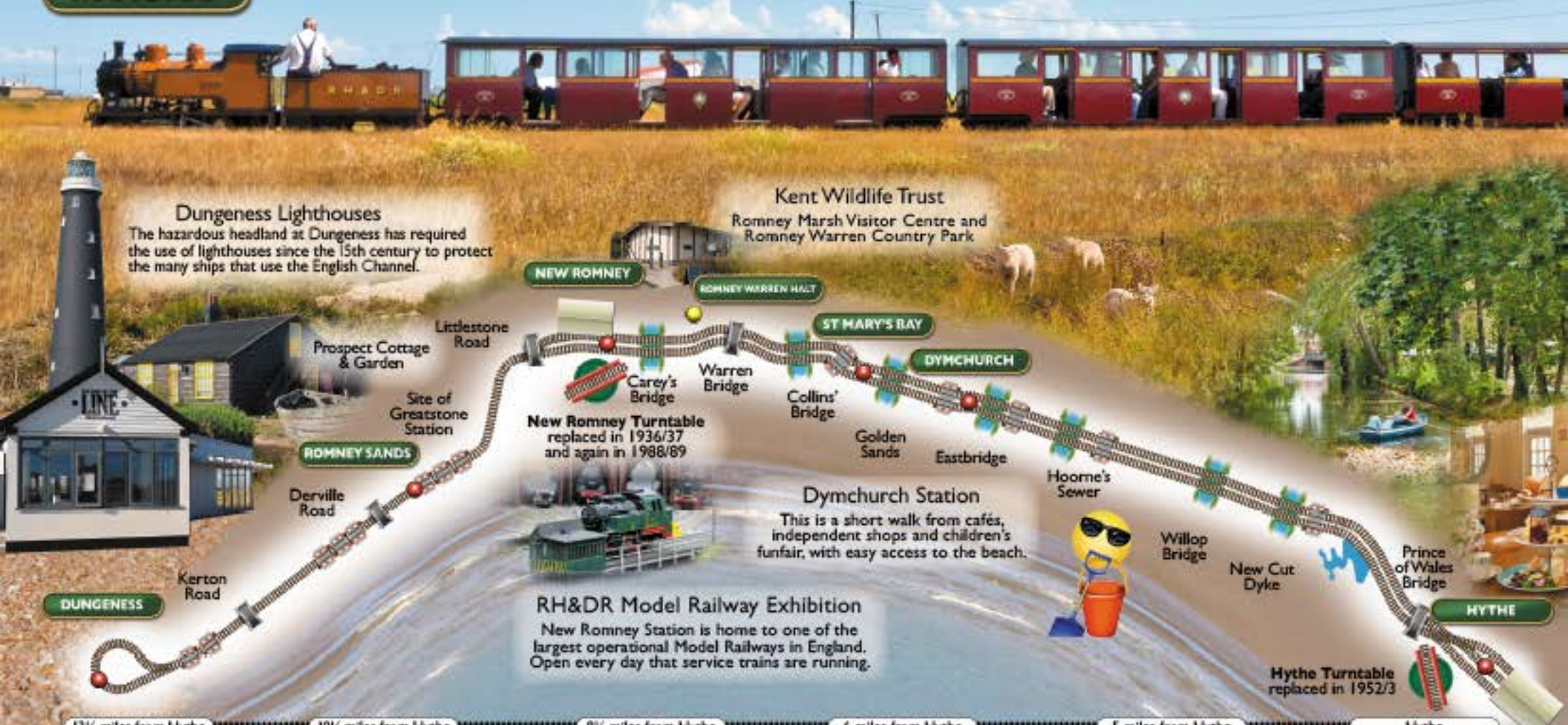


ROUTE MAP
